



“Sunday Market” opens on Sunday

Wednesday, 20 May 2020

“Dimitrovgrad Sunday Market” will open from this Sunday, announced the mayor Ivo Dimov at a today press conference with the representatives of the Municipal Crisis Staff Dr. Silvia Yaneva, expert in RHI - Haskovo and Dr. Valentin Palashev, Deputy Manager of MHAT “St. .Ekaterina ”, as well as the chairman of the City Council commission “Trade and Municipal Markets” Sasho Spasov.

"Protecting the health of citizens is of priority importance, despite the significant losses that the municipality suffers from the fact that the market is not working. The responsibility for life and health of people is ours. On Monday we held a general meeting in which the opinions were divergent with arguments “for” and “against”. The market will work in stages, this week will open only on Sunday, and if the epidemiological situation is well, the next week the market will work as usual. I understand the traders on the market who have not worked for more than two months, but on the other side are the worries of the people in the city. The market is specific and cannot be compared by analogue with malls or other markets. However, we are introducing strict measures for traders and users of the sites. We recommend to the citizens the all anti-epidemiological prescriptions in order to be able to protect the environment in general ", said the mayor Ivo Dimov.

The expert from RHI-Haskovo and a member of the Municipal Crisis Staff Dr. Silvia Yaneva added that a large part of the anti-epidemiological measures in the country are dropped in general and the citizens increasingly show that they are starting to take care of their safety - they wear masks, wash their hands. We need to learn to live with the virus. Fear is not a good advisor. Regarding the market, we will monitor the situation, the expert



said.

The committee of the local parliament is irresistible that the market must work. "We consider the opinion of the medics to be justified, but categorically think that the market should work", expressed the opinion of the commission its chairman Mr. Sasho Spasov.

Dr. Palashev shared his fears that the opening of the Market will create conditions for the spread of the infection and invited traders and visitors to comply with safety regulations.

The Sunday market will be open from 7.00 a.m. to 02.00 p.m. on Sunday 24.05.2020. At the same time the Automobile Market will not work. The measure is being implemented to reduce the flow of people visiting both markets.

The work of the Sunday market will be allowed in compliance with anti-epidemic measures by traders, owners and sellers of sites on the market. It is obligatory for traders to wear protective face masks or a protective helmet, to disinfect their sites and to place disinfectants in prominent places, to monitor and prevent crowds in front of and in their sites. For traders, owners and users of fast food restaurants on the territory of the Sunday Market it is allowed to visit open-air commercial areas in strict compliance with the anti-epidemic measures introduced by order of the Minister of Health, such as table placement in a way that ensures a distance of not less than 1.5 m between them and not more than four persons at one table or one family, the service personnel should wear a protective face mask or protective helmet, and it is recommended to wear gloves. . The surfaces of the tables and chairs should be cleaned and disinfected after each client, and the toilets every hour. Disinfectants for use by visitors should be placed in prominent places in the restaurants on the market. Visitors to the market are recommended to wear personal protective equipment (mask, scarf, helmet, etc.), to observe the official distance of 1.5 m., not to cause crowds in front of and in the sites on the territory of the Sunday market. Twice a day the Market will be disinfected before its opening and after the end of working hours. Public toilets will be disinfected every hour.
